PARCC Testing Continues This Week for Third and Fourth Graders

PARCC testing began Tuesday, March 3rd. Fourth and fifth graders have completed their testing and are now finishing make-up testing. Third graders will test from Monday, March 16th through Friday, March 20th. On Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday, students will take the English/Language Arts units of PARCC. On Thursday and Friday, students will take the Math units for PARCC. The order of units during test week was the same for all grades.

We'd like to encourage full attendance during your child's week of testing. Students who miss testing will need to make up the test. For make-up testing, it is possible that students may have to take more than one unit a day. This is not ideal. Inclement weather has also contributed to the need to make up missed testing days.

Please make sure your child is well rested the night before testing and arrives at school on time each day.
